

AASES Student visa application checklist **(for students under the age of 18)**

To avoid delays in the processing of your application, you should only submit your application once all of the below documentation is available. Further documentation may be requested by your case officer, but the below documentation should be regarded as the minimum required in order to make a complete application.

Have you completed the most up-to-date form 157A – design date 04/15)? <i>See bottom right-hand corner of the application form to check.</i> The most up-to-date form 157A can be downloaded from: www.immi.gov.au/allforms/pdf/157a.pdf	
Have you entered your residential address at question 18 ? <i>Please provide the address in your home country, not the Australian address.</i>	
Have you answered the relevant questions on form 157A? - Health questions 80-92 - Character question 93	
Have <u>all</u> legal guardians signed questions 101, 103 and 113 ?	
Have you attached one passport-sized photograph for each applicant to the application form?	
AASES FORM	
Does the AASES form indicate the nominated welfare period?	
Have parts A and B been completed and part C signed by parents/ legal guardians?	
ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION	
Have you included a clear copy of your passport? <i>We require the page(s) showing the applicant's personal details, the issue and expiry date of the passport and the issuing authority.</i> Please do <u>not</u> send us your original passport	
Have you included a copy of your birth certificate that indicates all parents' names?	
Have you included a copy of all parents'/ legal guardians' passports or identity cards showing their photo and signature? <i>Note: if a single parent/ legal guardian holds sole custody, please provide a recent official statement from the relevant authority.</i>	
Have you attached separate evidence of Overseas Student Health Cover? <i>Note: OSHC must be taken out for the entire welfare period as per dates at part A on the AASES form.</i> See link for more information on OSHC: http://www.border.gov.au/Trav/Stud/More/Health-Insurance-for-Students
